

A note about Peace: from Sherry Russell

In July, the U. S. Peace Corp celebrated it's 50th anniversary of work in Samoa. The first Peace Corps volunteers went to Samoa in 1967, after the government of Samoa requested assistance from the Peace Corps.

President John F. Kennedy started the Peace Corps in 1961 as an agency whose mission was - and still is - to promote global peace and friendship. Sergeant Shriver, who was the first Director of the Peace Corps, said "What can change the world today is the same thing that has changed it in the past - an idea and the service of dedicated, committed individuals to that idea". Since 1967 close to 2000 Peace Corps Volunteers have lived and worked in Samoa in service of that idea.
